This Quick Installation Guide only provides the basic instructions. For more detail instructions, please refer to the User's Manual in the provided CD.

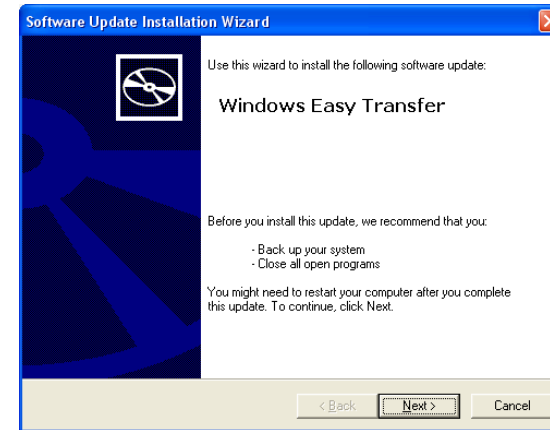
Note: Do **NOT** plug the Data Transfer Cable to your Windows XP computer before you install the Windows Easy Transfer. Please follow the steps below to proceed.

On Windows Vista:

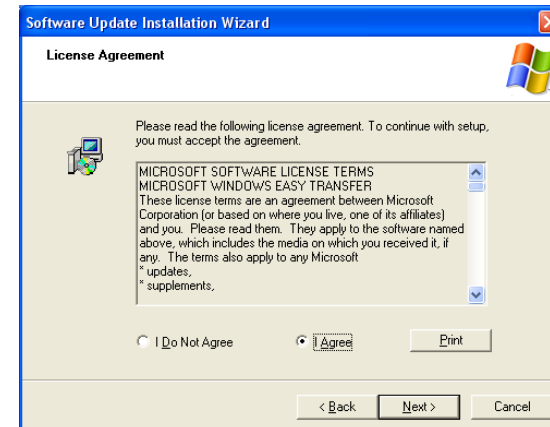
Simply plug the adapter to the USB port on your computer and it's ready to use. No further installation is required.

On Windows XP:

Step 1 Insert the installation CD into your CD-ROM drive.



Step 4 After reading the license agreement, select **I Agree** and click **Next**.



Step 5 Click **Finish** to complete the software installation.

Step 6 Plug the Data Transfer Cable to the USB ports on both your Vista and XP computers. When Easy Transfer Cable screen appears, select **Transfer files and settings** to launch Windows Easy Transfer.

Step 3 On your source computer, select the files and settings you want to transfer and proceed as prompted.

Step 4 Go to your target computer. The message “The transfer is complete” will be displayed when transferring is complete.

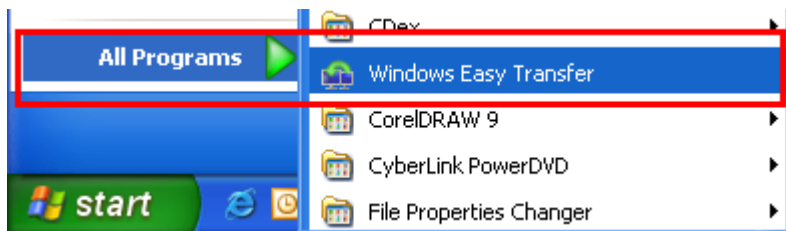
Section 2

Using Windows Easy Transfer

Step 1 Start Windows Easy Transfer on **both** computers. To start the utility:

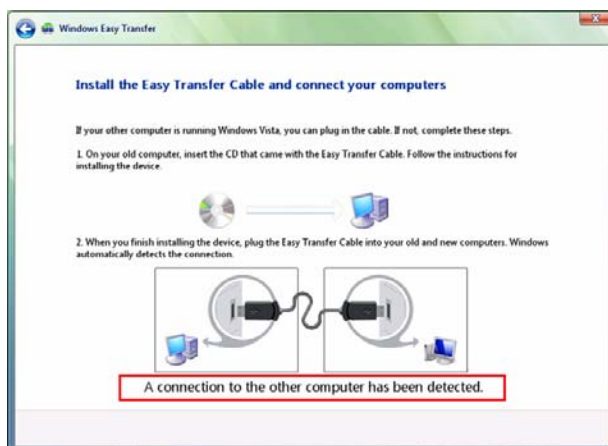
On Windows Vista: Select Start > Programs > Accessories > System Tools > Windows Easy Transfer.

On Windows XP: Select Start > Programs > Windows Easy Transfer.



Step 2 Follow the on-screen instructions to proceed on both computers.

Proceed until the message “**A connection to the other computer has been detected**” appears at the bottom on both computers, meaning they have detected each other.
